Nomination Guidelines

- Any individual associated with a sport in the Olympic and/or Paralympic movements may be nominated.
- Nominees should be well-known for their exemplary leadership, sustained contributions to sport, advancement of sport, organizational skills or technological endeavors, character, communication abilities and leadership accomplishments. Nominees must be members of the U.S. Olympic and Paralympic family.
- Nominees may also be U.S. Olympians or Paralympians who have made important contributions to the Olympic and Paralympic movements, and have been retired for 10 or more years.
- Nominations may be submitted by a member of the U.S. Olympic and Paralympic family.
- The award winner must be in attendance for the official presentation of the award.
- Note: 2017 nominees who were not selected will be considered for the 2018 award.

Nomination Form

Information in support of the nominee must be typed and should not exceed five pages. The criteria for the George M. Steinbrenner Sport Leadership Award must be clearly shown in the supporting information. The nominee must be a member of the United States Olympic and Paralympic family. Include a letter addressing the nominee's abilities as they relate to the criteria.

Criteria for the award include individuals who have:

- made sustained contributions to sport (s) in the Olympic or Paralympic movement
- communication skills and leadership qualities that personify excellence
- advanced sport at the national or international level
- improved sport through organizational or technological endeavors
- maintained a record of distinguished assistance to sport organizations through committee work or other responsibilities
