FIJI OLYMPIC ORDER 2017 Selection Criteria

The FIJI OLYMPIC ORDER may on an annual basis be awarded to one or two individuals who shall have excelled in any of the following categories:

- ADMINISTRATION
- MANAGEMENT
- COACHING/TECHNICAL
- MEDICAL/SPORTS SCIENCE

CRITERIA: Any person nominated for this award shall have attained the following minimum criteria:

- Excelled in the area of Sports Administration, Sports Management, Coaching and Technical aspects of Sports Development, and Sports Medicine.
- Provided a minimum of 15 years of contribution at the highest level of service in the development of sports.
- Extraordinary services provided over a shorter period of time which results in the attainment of the highest level of recognition shall be eligible for consideration.
- Any individual nominated shall be of high moral character and integrity and shall be a well respected member of the sporting community.
- All candidates shall be free of any criminal conviction and must at all times maintain the highest sporting ethics and be generally perceived to be possessing an attitude and ability of good and fair sportsmanship.

NOMINATIONS: Nominations are invited from FASANOC affiliates for the Fiji Olympic Order award. All nominations, with supporting documentation, shall be submitted in writing on the prescribed forms provided by FASANOC.

JUDGING: FASANOC shall appoint a panel of independent judges to select a maximum of two candidates who, in the opinion of the judges, shall be most worthy of receiving the FIJI OLYMPIC ORDER in accordance with the established criteria.

PRESENTATION: The awards will be presented at the Hall of Fame Dinner to be held in March 2017.
